State law prohibits the University from extending credit. Therefore, fee payment cannot be delayed beyond the start of classes or financed by the Executive Master of Science in Taxation Program or the University. An exception to the advance payment policy will be made only for those program participants who have been granted financial aid by the University (scholarship, fellowship, loan) and granted deferment .

If a participant expects to receive aid from other sources for all or part of the program fees but will not receive that aid in time to meet the advance payment deadline, he/she should arrange for financing through a bank or other financial institution to ensure that program fees are paid on a timely basis.
