Why the MACC at FIU?

- Satisfies the 30 credit hours required beyond the bachelor's degree for Florida CPA licensure
- Set schedule and locations to choose from:
Weeknights at Modesto Maidique Campus (MMC) or Saturdays at Pembroke Pines
- Fast-Track Schedule:
10 month Audit Track
12 month Tax Track (with tax season break)
- Employment and career development opportunities through our Career Management Services office, tailored to the Accounting professional

What is needed to be eligible for Admission?

- Four year Bachelor's degree in Business Administration with a minimum 3.0 GPA in upper level coursework
- Minimum score of 500 on the GMAT or 1000 (old scale) on the GRE

GMAT or GRE Exemptions granted to:

- Holders of a graduate degree from an AACSB accredited university; or
- Persons who have passed all parts of the CPA exam; or
- FIU Bachelor's in Accounting with a minimum 3.25 GPA in upper level coursework AND a 3.0 average in ACG4101, ACG4111, ACG 4341 and TAX 4001

Financial Assistance

The MACC program is eligible for Federal Financial Aid. Limit number of scholarships/assistantships are available for most qualified students.

Application Procedures

1. Complete the online application at: <http://gradschool.fiu.edu/admission.html>
2. Submit the \$30 application fee
3. Submit sealed official transcripts from all previously attend colleges and/or universities (FIU alumni skip to step 4)
If official transcripts are not in English a second copy must be requested for translation agency
4. Submit official GMAT or GRE scores (FIU code is 5206)
5. Submit a current professional resume
6. Participate in a personal interview
7. Up to two letters of recommendation (optional)
8. Complete the Florida Resident Affidavit form
9. TOEFL or IELTS score is required for any applicant who has not earned a degree from an English-language university
10. International students requiring I-20s must also provide a bank letter, declaration of finances and sponsor letter

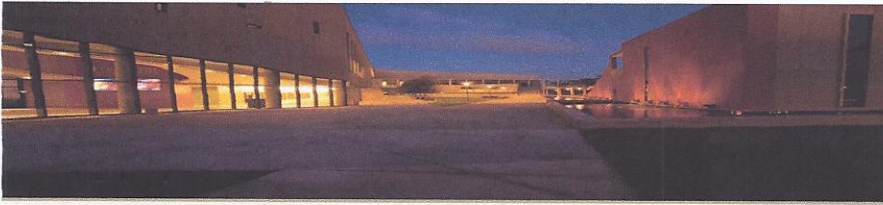

Audit Track

Duration: 10 months
Schedule: Tuesday & Thursday evenings,
MMC Fall and Spring OR
All Day Saturday, Pines Fall only

Duration: 12 months, including tax season break
