- This last summer, you will enter our "Practice Internship" where you will gain actual hands on experience through interactions with our various clients in the line of business that you have chosen.

### Why should I participate?

This program is more than just a trip to Hollywood to be among the stars! As a rising star in your own right, for three days, you will have the opportunity to network with industry leaders, professors, and KPMG professionals from all across the country. With successful participation, you will then be eligible to continue the journey in the FDL program. Through this process, in addition to receiving internship opportunities that could last for up to a three-year period, you are also eligible to receive up to a total of \$6,000 in scholarships after full completion of the program. ### When is the Leadership Conference?

The program will be held **Monday, July 14 – Wednesday, July 16, 2008**, in Hollywood, CA. KPMG will cover approved travel, lodging, and meal expenses.

### How do I apply?

To be considered for this program, you must have a cumulative 3.5 or higher grade point average and be interested in pursuing a career in business. In addition, you must submit a completed program application form, along with your resume and current transcript to your Faculty Advisor. Your Advisor will review your documents and make a determination as to whether or not to nominate you for the program. Your Advisor must submit all materials, including nomination form, to KPMG by March 7, 2008. KPMG will

review the materials and students will be selected for interviews. All decisions regarding who is selected for the program will be made by April 2008.
