FIU business school to launch Miami branch

Florida International University's Chapman Graduate School of Business is launching a downtown Miami branch at Macy's Florida corporate offices.

The business school's downtown center will be on the sixth floor of Macy's, at 22 E. Flagler St. Beginning in August, the school will offer a new 18-month MBA degree at the facility as well as an executive Master of Science in Taxation program.

In addition, in January 2006 the school plans to offer a master's in finance that specializes in international banking and and a master's in international real estate, a new offering.

Applications are being accepted for all four programs. An informational session will be held at the Intercontinental Hotel in downtown Miami on June 28 from 5:30-8:30 p.m.
