The International Business Honor Society (IBHS) will award one \$1,000 scholarship to an IBHS student member in 2012.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Undergraduate applicants must be enrolled full-time, have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 on a 4.0-point scale, and be admitted to the College of Business Administration (CBA).

Graduate student applicants must be enrolled in a Chapman business degree program and clearly pursuing an emphasis area in business or a business related program (MBA or MIB among others), and completed at least six hours of graduate course work with at least 3.5 GPA on a 4.0-point scale.

JUDGING CRITERIA

The judging committee will evaluate scholarship applicants and select the scholarship winner based on the following criteria:

- 40% Student involvement in IBHS
- 25% Academic achievement
- 20% Letter of recommendation from a faculty member
- 15% Additional leadership and service activities/work experience

TIMELINE

Application deadline: March 15, 2012.

Applicants notified of results: April 5, 2012 during the Student Leadership Group Award Ceremony.

Recipient awarded in two parts: First half during the 2012 fall semester and second half during the 2013 spring semester.

HOW TO APPLY

All applications must be submitted via e-mail in PDF format to Yanyn San Luis at ysanluis@fiu.edu, with "IBHS Scholarship – Name Last Name" on the subject line (please remember to type *your* name and last name). To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must submit the following information:

- Completed application
- Copy of letter of admission to the CBA or to Chapman's School of Business
- Letter from IBHS certifying semesters' points
- Copy of your most recent unofficial University transcript
- Letter of recommendation from faculty member
- Current résumé

**If selected for the scholarship, students will be required to submit an official transcript at the time prior to receiving funds.*
