- Applicants must be currently admitted to the Master of Accounting program at FIU.
- Awardees must have an undergraduate cumulative GPA greater than 3.699.
- Awardees must earn a grade of "B" or higher in each course while in the Master of Accounting program. A lower grade (including a DR) will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship for any remaining classes.
- Ability to secure the scholarship is dependent on space availability and funding.
- The scholarship is awarded on a semester basis and can be discontinued at any point throughout the duration of the program.
- Federal student aid may be adjusted as a result of the posting of this scholarship. The Financial Aid Office will send a
 revised award letter should any adjustment take place.
- Students are eligible for one scholarship per semester. Therefore, this scholarship cannot be combined with another FIU or COB Scholarship (except the MACC CPA Exam Scholarship).
