Terms and Conditions

I acknowledge and accept that by registering for class(es) at Florida International University, I understand and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. I am responsible for any class(es) I am registered for by the program and for adhering to program deadlines for enrollment activity.
2. I am responsible for the payment of any class(es) for which the program registers me.
3. I must inform the program of any class I do not want on my permanent record by the end of the Drop/Add period: one week after classes start or as published in the program policies. This will entitle me to a full refund for the class (es) I request dropped.
4. I am liable for all fees associated with classes that I have requested to be dropped after the Drop/Add deadline and will receive a permanent DR grade on my transcript.
5. I am not eligible to make an Academic Appeal for a full refund of tuition for any class(es) I fail to request the drop by the Drop/Add deadline.
6. Should I not pay tuition and fees by the payment deadline, all of my classes will be cancelled; this may affect my financial aid awards.
7. I will have the opportunity, for a limited period of time, to have my courses restored with full and immediate payment including late registration fees and other payment obligations.
8. FIU email is the e-address to which all official notices from the university, college and program will be sent.

If applicable, I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to review and understand the "Terms and Conditions" of my financial aid awards. I understand that my financial aid is packaged based on full-time enrollment (Graduate-9 credits) and will be adjusted according to my actual enrollment at the end of the drop/add period. If I accept my financial aid, I understand that I am liable for all fees associated with the courses I am enrolled in at the end of the drop/add period.
