

INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS SUMMER SCHOOL

The College of Business at FIU continues to be a global leader in international business programs. Through the International Business Summer School (IBSS) Program, students would complete one to four academic modules & receive a certificate of completion from FIU while possibly transferring back credits back to your home university. All students will complete from 3 to 12 credit hours in residence at FIU's Miami, Florida campus.



Join Florida International University's College of Business for International Summer School, featuring classes in our international business program, ranked No. 2 in the nation by U.S. News & World in its 2021 Best College rankings. This summer program is open to FIU Business students, international students and students from our international partner universities within the FIU College of Business network. Choose one or more three-week modules to attend, and earn course credits that are posted to an official FIU transcript. Courses and grades may transfer back to your home institution.

FORMAT

International Business Summer School will include four modules; each will include one course, which will meet for three hours a day/five days a week. Each module will run for three weeks, and students may enroll in any number of modules. FIU Business students must be approved for each module by their Academic Advisor, to avoid excess credit hours.

ENT 4704– International Entrepreneurship Pre-requisite (for FIU students): ENT 4113 Entrepreneurship: New Business Development

THE PROGRAM COST INCLUDES:

ADDITIONAL COSTS

- FIU on-campus housing
- International student health insurance

WHAT IS THE PRICE OF THE PROGRAM?

- Cost of Summer program is US\$1,250 3 week module or US \$5,00 for all 4 modules
- Housing expenses for visiting students are paid separately and are US \$850 per three-week module, or US \$3,400 for 12 weeks

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

- \$30 application fee
- Completed secondary/high school
- Financial statement
- Students from non-English speaking countries must demonstrate proficiency in the English language. Applicants who haven't successfully completed any college-level English course (ENC1101 or equivalent), must present a minimum score of 550 paper-based or 80 internet-based ("iBT") score on the Test of English as a Foreign Language ("TOEFL"). A minimum of 6.5 on the International English Language Testing System ("IELTS") can also be submitted as proof of English-language proficiency. Students applying from partner universities under approved agreements whose programs are fully taught in English or have similar English-language proficiency requirements comparable to FIU may demonstrate they meet this requirement
