DEVELOPING MANAGERS: Florida International University is offering Miami-Dade County workers an MBA in public management. In August, 18 students began the 18-month MBA program with 13 traditional courses and two electives in fields like public administration, said **Flavia Iuspa**, a program manager at FIU's Chapman Graduate School of Business. The program is open to county employees with five years' managerial experience, she said. The county reimburses half the tuition.
