JM Family Enterprises is top woman-led firm

Florida International University's Center for Leadership and The Commonwealth Institute South Florida on Wednesday released its list of the top women-led business in Florida at a luncheon at the Four Seasons Hotel in Miami.

The list is the result of a first-time survey that shows the top women-led business in Florida contribute \$12 million to the economy and are mostly in industries such as building materials, construction and staffing.

The survey identified the largest women-led company in the state as JM Family Enterprises in Deerfield Beach with 9.4 billion in revenues, chaired by Patricia Moran.

The center in partnership with The Commonwealth Institute South Florida, a peer mentoring organization for women CEOs and senior executives, plans to annually replicate the study.
