

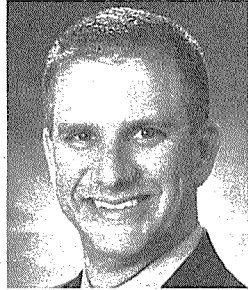

**Hospital Corporation names Kendall CEO**

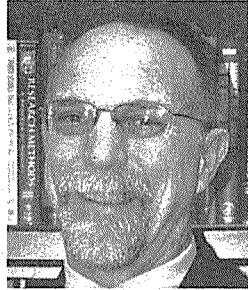
The Hospital Corporation of America East Florida Division has named **Scott A. Cihak** chief executive officer of the Kendall Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Cihak was previously chief executive officer of Columbia Hospital in West Palm Beach.

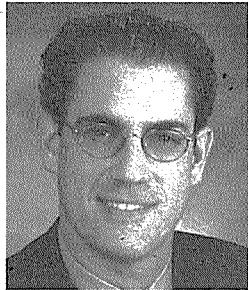

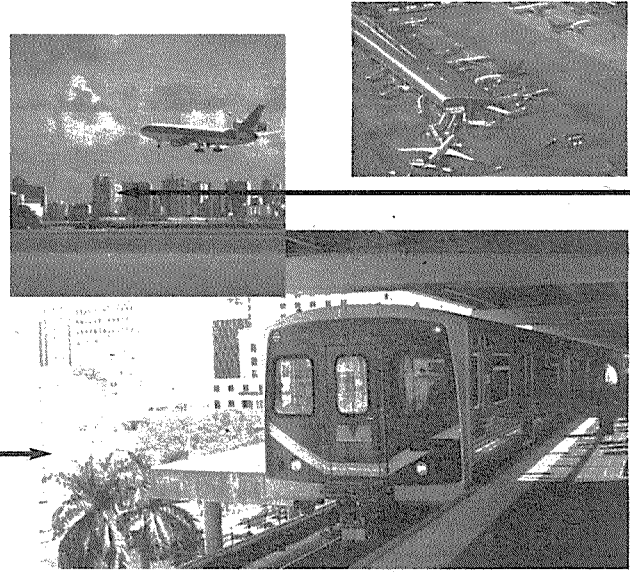
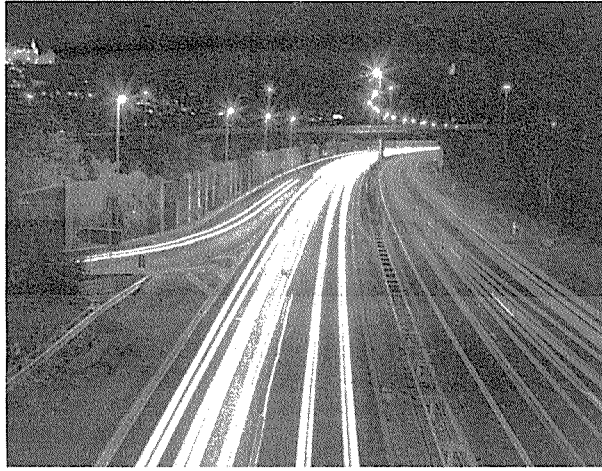
