Ten years ago, Dana A. Forgione co-authored an educational accounting murder mystery novel, "Costly Reflections in a Midas Mirror." In the tale of drugs, murder and

international terrorists, the hero uses accounting to solve the crime and to track down calculating culprits.

Forgione, who teaches at and directs Florida International University's School of Accounting, said he believes a good teacher makes learning fun.

His biggest challenge, he said, is to continue building the school into a world-class operation with limited state resources. Forgione's top goal in the next year, though, is to finalize commitments to expand the School of Accounting's presence into cooperative programs in China.
